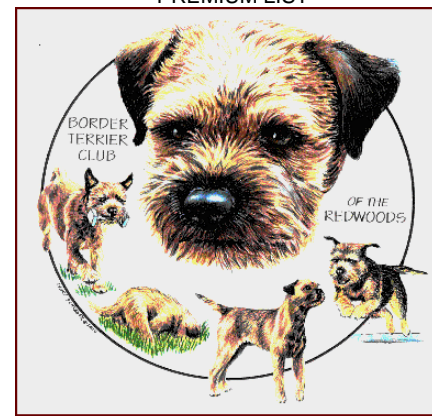

**DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE**

**From the South via US 101** Take 101 north to Santa Rosa. Exit onto Highway 12 exit towards Sonoma (east); **stay in the right-hand lane.** From Hwy 12, take the first--almost immediate--exit (South E Street/Downtown). Go straight through the light at the bottom of the offramp, which puts you onto Bennett Valley Road. You will almost immediately pass, on your right, the fairgrounds racetrack and the fair marquee; take your next right onto Brookwood Ave. At the end of Brookwood, turn right onto Allen, which becomes Aston Ave. Just ahead on your right is a booth entrance for the fairgrounds. Enter and take the right side road. Head straight until you see the Lytle Cow Palace sign on the building. Turn left before the building and park in the marked parking areas.

**From the East via CA 12** From Highway 12, westbound, take the Downtown exit. Turn left at the stop light. This leads you to the entrance to the Sonoma County Fairgrounds. Follow the instructions above.

**Illegible entries** will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Trial Secretary will add a 20.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries will be designated as follows: Online entries 50%; Paper entries 50%. **RIBBONS, AWARDS, AND PRIZES**

Rosettes will be awarded for 1-4 place in each jump height in each class to dogs with qualifying scores. Dog toys at a value of \$1.00 will be awarded to 1<sup>ST</sup> place in each jump height in each class to dogs with qualifying scores. A green ribbon will be awarded to all dogs with qualifying scores. Rosettes will be awarded to Excellent B dogs who qualify in Standard and JWW on the same day while quantities are available. A special MACH Ribbon will be awarded to anyone completing a MACH. A PAX Rosette will be awarded to all dog and handler teams that attain their Preferred Excellent title.

**All prizes, awards and ribbons must be picked up before the end of the show. No ribbons, etc. will be mailed after the show.**

## SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The BTCR and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The BTCR reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the BTCR or any official thereof.

All dogs must be on leash at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course.

## REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, weather or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee.

No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is injured after the closing of the trial.

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in Agility Trials. Bitches in season are not allowed on the show grounds. As such, the club will refund half of the entry fees per day for bitches unable to compete for this reason if the Trial Secretary receives WRITTEN notice of withdrawal no later than 6pm, Thursday, Jan 14, 2010.

## RINGSIDE

Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging, if a valid copy of their jump height card was sent with their entry. Otherwise, they must be available for measuring prior to the start of their class. All dogs not needed for further judging will be excused.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

## MEASURING and HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION

***A valid copy of a dog's jump height card can be sent with every entry. Otherwise, they must be available for measuring prior to the start of their class.***

All agility dogs are required to have an Official Jump Height Card and exhibitors must be able to present it prior to running their dog(s) in any class or at any time during the trial upon request whether or not they have sent a copy of such with their entry. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the Judge of Record PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" or 26" height division. However, if a Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO) or an Agility Field Rep is present; ALL dogs without a valid Jump Height Card must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog before its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

## DOG ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are registerable breeds that have obtained an AKC ILP or PAL number. Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under six months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.
